Would like to pronounce far and wide throughout the Summits the format for the Coronet tournament to determine Their heirs, to be held Saturday, September 24 in the Shire of Corvaria. Read on for details!

Great and good gentles all. Set your eyes here that you may know that Their Highnesses Prince Amalric Blackhart and Tlatocapilli Z lay down the terms, conditions, and format for the coming Coronet Tournament in Corvaria on September 21 A.S. LIX.

1. All Competitors and Inspirations must be Summits residents.
2. All Competitors must have registered with the lists prior to the closing of said lists, before invocation.
3. Both Competitors and Inspirations shall be present at the tournament (unless otherwise authorized by the Coronets).
4. All Competitors and Inspirations are encouraged to bring painted shield tokens for display on the list field Board.
5. A donation of largesse for the new heirs is encouraged (but not required).
6. Format
  - a. The tournament shall be double elimination. If there are twenty or fewer competitors, each round will be best two out of three.
  - b. There shall be a destructive challenge in round one of the tournament.
  - c. Combatants shall "bring their best" for the challenge round through the semi-finals.
  - d. Finals shall be best Three of Five with changing weapon styles. Combatants shall agree to meet matched forms chosen for the list below for the first four rounds (assuming the Finals are not concluded in three).
    - i. Weapon and Shield
    - ii. Axe / Polearm
    - iii. Two weapon
    - iv. Great sword
    - v. (only if there is a final/ fifth round) Best/chosen form
  - e. Double Kills shall be refought immediately.
  - f. There shall be no shield restriction.
  - g. Bye fights will not be destructive.
